The Karuk Tribal TANF Program encourages Native American family's participation in the "Other Eligible" Services. Our goals are to provide to community members and their children, prevention services that meet TANF purposes 3 (prevent and reduce the incidence of out-of-wedlock pregnancies) and/or 4 (encourage the formation of two-parent families). Federal restrictions prohibit cash assistance to "Other Eligible" services, however, the prevention services provided are intended to benefit families in the community.
