### Position Announcement

#### Stewardship Intern(s) Age 15-18

32 hours/week at \$10.50/hour

The Mid Klamath Watershed Council (MKWC) invites applicants for a part-time stewardship intern position. Depending on grant funds, MKWC will hire up to 5-8 stewardship interns to assist us during the summer months in our Watershed Education, Fisheries, Foodsheds, and Plants programs. **The position(s) will begin July 10<sup>th</sup> and end August 17<sup>th</sup>.** Stewardship Interns will work on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (4 days per week) 8 hours per day.

#### Stewardship Interns will be responsible for:

- 1) Assisting MKWC Fisheries Crew with Creek Mouth restoration activities.
- 2) Assisting Invasive Plants Coordinator with removing prioritized invasive weeds.
- 3) Watering and maintaining Native Plant Garden, and collecting native grass seed.
- 4) Assisting in the Watershed Education, Foodsheds, and Panamnik Building Community programs.
- 5) Participating in an **overnight backpacking trip** to monitor invasive plant populations in the wilderness.
- 6) Completion of an independent project relating to one of MKWC's programs or projects.
- 7) Participating in a team work environment.



#### Position Requirements:

Applicants must have experience and a desire to work in the outdoors, ability to do physical labor, be punctual, have a flexible schedule, good references, and be willing to do overnight camping trips. Preference will be given to applicants who have participated in or volunteered in previous MKWC activities (Raft Trips, Outdoor School, workdays, etc.).

**The salary is CA state minimum wage, \$10.50/hour.**
